What is NYO Unite?

NYO Unite is an epic day of music-making with the entire NYO community, which takes place at six different locations across the UK this autumn.

Musicians from NYO and NYO Inspire will come together to explore music in instrument group and full orchestral rehearsals, working with conductor, Pablo Urbina, and NYO tutors.

If you would like to join the orchestral activity, apply to join NYO Inspire, a free musical adventure for teenagers who want music to be a bigger part of their lives but face barriers and lack of opportunity to progress.
